2 Ideal Location

The school is about a 3-minutes walk from JR Sakuragicho Station, which is situated as the access way to the "21 Century Future Port", the symbol towers of the international city, Yokohama. Yokohama Stadium, the public library, and various cultural, educational institutions are located close to our school.

When you are going to stay in Japan as a student, the first thing you have to do is to find a residence suitable enough for you. Generally, it is very difficult task. But in our case, we are preparing very economical and comfortable residences for our students. Therefore, you don't have to worry about that. Mostly, our student residences are located within 20 to 30 minutes in commuting from our school.

5 Reliable as an Organization

Aishin International Institute was established by a non-profit organization sanctioned by the Japanese Government. This organization is a member of a group managing old people's homes, clinics, nurseries, and so on. The organization is very active in international exchange programs with getting support from many people.



Course Formation

Aishin International Institute offers three courses of different lengths and starting terms. Students are placed into appropriate classes based on their Japanese language abilities as assessed by a placement test and oral interview. 10 to 12 students are placed in to each class. Class ability levels are ranked according to the following criteria.

1. Beginner Level

Regarding 4 Japanese skills (listening, speaking, reading, writing) as introducing to the first level, trying to master Japanese language of basic ability and minimum necessary living in Japan.

2. Basic Level

Completely master basic Japanese language for going up to be able to study middle level. For getting ability of JLPT N4 level, trying to master vocabulary and grammar expression in main text.

3. First step of Middle Level

On the way of stepping up basic level to middle one, completely master basic ability of Japanese language with reviewing basic level and trying to be able to move to middle level. Also beginning the class for studying JLPT N3.

4. Middle Level

Studying Japanese language for going on to university and getting the job in Japan. Also studying the reading of concrete sentence in society and conversation in business. Getting ability of JLPT N3.

5. Middle Advanced Level

Reviewing the middle level, reducing the trouble of studying till advanced level. Trying to be able to understand abstract expression of Japanese language. Getting the ability JLPT N3-N2.

6. Advanced Level

For getting practice ability of Japanese language, trying to master abstract sentence and conversation of Japanese language. Getting ability of JLPT N2 level.

7. Graduate Level

Studying academic contents of literature and lecture in Japanese university and graduate school, also trying to be able to understand high level of Japanese language. Getting ability of JLPT N2-N1.

EVALUATION

Evaluation of the student is made on the basis of class attendance and the results of both midterm and end of term examinations. Students need to attend more than 90%. Students who attend classes more than 56% in both midterm and end of term examinations will be awarded a Certificate of Completion of the course.

2. The person who can bear the school expenses and the cost of living.
3. The person who have the ability that is higher than the Japanese Language Proficiency Test N5 level.
